# hello summer!

Welcome to our STEAM and nature-based summer camp, where kids can explore, play, and learn while learning STEAM education. Our camp is run by certified educators who specialize in conscious discipline and develop mentally appropriate practices to promote physical, mental, and emotional development. La Creare Schools Summer Camp turns your child's ordinary summer into a summer of exciting exploration with a variety of educational and creative activities for ages 1 through 9. Through hands-on experiences, in-school field trips, and themed events, we make our learners' summer camp fun, yet educational, getting immersed in a wide range of programs including music, art, yoga, cooking and dance, all immersed in Spanish learning.

Each day, we'll start with a morning meeting outside or inside, play games that promote teamwork and cooperation and engage in nature crafts that allow us to use our creativity and imagination. These activities will help to build gross and fine motor skills, improve attention and focus, and promote a sense of mindfulness and well-being. After our activities, we'll have a snack break, where campers can refuel and recharge. We'll then head back out for some messy play, where campers can let their imaginations run wild and explore different textures and sensory experiences. We'll also engage in ice and water play, where campers can cool off and have fun while developing coordination and gross motor skills. Throughout the camp, our educators will be available to provide support and guidance to campers as they navigate new experiences and challenges. We'll also focus on promoting emotional regulation and social skills with activities designed to encourage communication, empathy, and self-regulation.

## Week 1 – Once Upon a Summer!

---

Campers embark on a magical week of storytelling, character exploration, and imaginative learning. Each day features a new adventure: Moana’s tropical science, the Royal Kingdom’s creative play, Mickey & Friends’ teamwork challenges, & Inside Out’s emotional discovery. Through STEAM, sensory activities, & hands-on projects, learners build creativity, confidence, & social-emotional skills in a joyful, story-filled environment.

## Week 3 – Mad Scientists

Let us deal with the mess and clean up from all the fun experiments your kiddos want to do in the summer! Slime? Yes! Glitter on everything? Bring it on! How to splatter paint? Let’s do it! We’ll be taking on all the fun and messy experiments and learning a few skills along the way, like measurement and prediction skills.

#### La Creare Schools SUMMER CAMP Enrollment Policies

**Enrollment** – To reserve your space, a completed enrollment form with deposit must be received. Payment in full must be received prior to the first day of summer camp.

**Tuition** – Half of the tuition is due by May 2nd . The other half of the tuition is due June 15th . Tuition may be paid by checks (payable to "La Creare Schools"), ACH, credit card via Brightwheel. There will be a \$25.00 fee charge for canceled checks. Tuition is not prorated for sickness or any absence.

Switching days will not be permitted, however if space is available, you can add a day to your schedule at \$45/day.

**Sibling Discount** – Deduct 5% from the lowest tuition for the second child. For families of three or more children a 10% deduction of total tuition will be deducted.

**Make-Ups** – Make-up days are limited to two per family only on a space availability basis during the summer and may not be carried over into another week or semester.

**Refunds and Credits** – If you notify La Creare Schools in writing of a withdrawal by June 1st , you will receive a full refund of the tuition paid. Tuition is non-refundable after June 1st . La Creare Schools has the right to refund tuition to any family at any time during the summer camp program.

**Protection of Methods** – The methods used at La Creare Schools are proprietary. Use of our program in proprietary methods, outside our premises, by individuals not authorized or licensed by La Creare Schools in writing is strictly prohibited. Such unauthorized use may cause irreparable damage to La Creare Schools.

**Lost or Broken Items** – La Creare Schools is not responsible for any items brought to summer camp that may get lost, broken or stolen. Please do not bring items to summer camp that may run the risk of getting lost or broken.

## Q&A



**1 Do you have to be a current La Creare student to attend the summer camp?**

Yes, lunch is included with our full day camp. An afternoon snack is also provided. Students only need to bring a water bottle.

**2 Is lunch included with a full day camp?**

No, all students must pack a lunch and water bottle.

**3 Does La Creare allow you to register for individual days of camp?**

Unfortunately not at this time.

**4 If I register my child for the summer camp, do the weeks need to be consecutive?**

No, the weeks do not need to be consecutive. You must register your child for at least two weeks to participate in our summer camp program, but these weeks can be non-consecutive, allowing flexibility in your scheduling.

**5 Are in-school field trips costs added to the tuition fees?**

No, field trips are not included in the camp fees. Some in-house field trips may require a small fee of less than \$15. However, materials and activities are already included in the tuition fees.

**6 What if my child has allergies?**

If your child has a specific allergy, please list them on our dietary restriction letter so that we can make appropriate food substitutions. Due to the high number of children with peanut allergies, we do not serve peanut products.

**7 How do you use technology in learning?**

La Creare Educators use technology as learning tools and a means of communication. We feel it's important to teach children how to use devices they will encounter in school, so they are given opportunities to use them for educational play and research. The use of televisions or computers for passive viewing is not part of La Creare School's curriculum.
